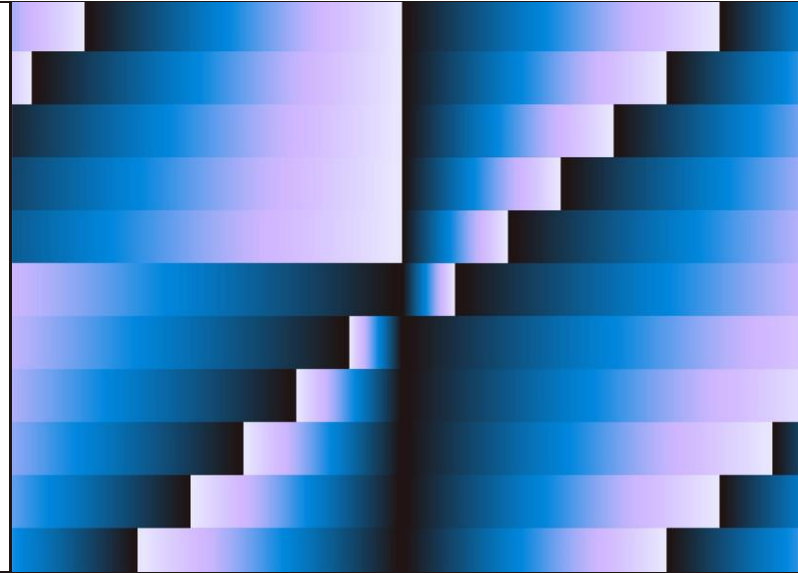

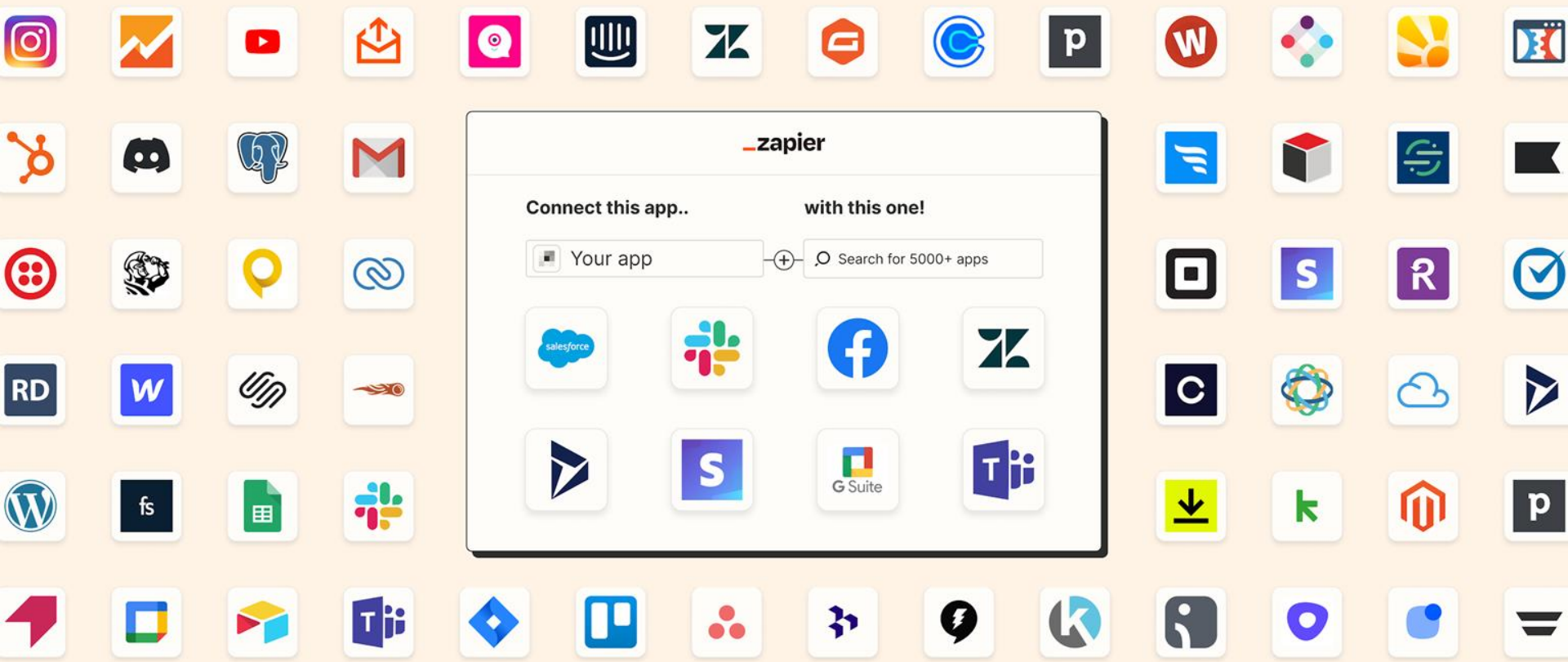

Zap is our term for the automated workflows you set up between your apps.

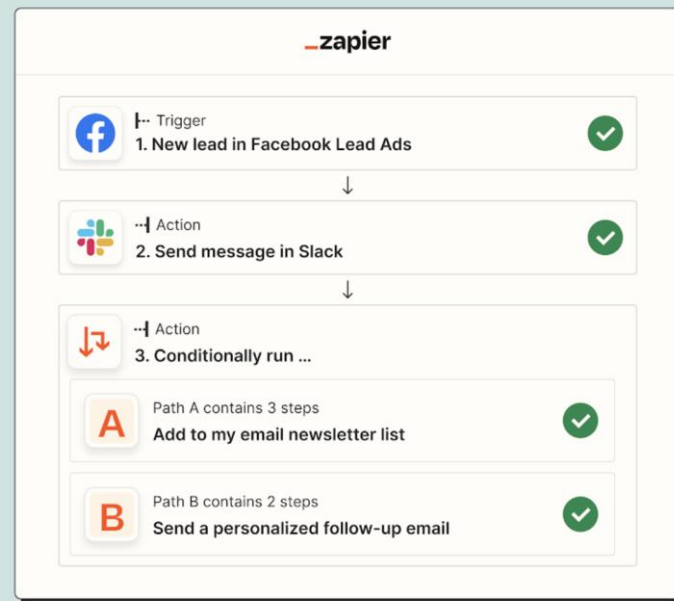
Trigger

Actions & Tasks

Actions are events that happen after your Trigger.

Every time Zapier performs an Action, that's what we call a Task.

Problem(s)

When building and running Zaps, customers encounter errors and have to spend time debugging and fixing their Zap. The goal of this project is to help customers spend less time debugging their Zaps and get their Zaps running again quickly.

Solution



Lessons Learned

- Keeping the prompt size within the token limits while also providing OpenAI with enough information to give a good recommendation is a delicate balance
- Not all erroring Zaps can be supported. For example, some errors such as authentication errors or 500 server/partner errors cannot be fixed by a ZDL change

Operating Principles for AI Projects

- Focus on speed to market and customer-facing launches
 - Reduce scope to enable rapid shipping to validate with customers.
- Optimize for Open Betas + Public launch moments
 - Position Zapier publicly as the tool that enables users to build with AI.
- Reduce split team focus
 - Go all in when you have a priority project to learn together.
- Default to transparency and escalation
 - Frequently communicate blockers, areas that lack clarity, and progress towards milestones.
- Establish success and graduation criteria upfront
 - Keep the feedback loop as short as possible: think in weeks, not months.

Technical Approach Recommendations

- Consolidate Reliability Efforts.
 - Duplication of work is acceptable when we're testing multiple solutions to quickly evaluate different approaches
- Build an Evaluation Suite.
 - A dataset of "given these inputs, this is a good answer" that you can use to measure the quality of your AI-based services.
 - This should also be the single place to collect and track  /  feedback from users.
- Put it Behind APIs.
 - An API enables any team to create capabilities quickly and efficiently.
- Think Buy as well as Build.
 - Consider integrating with external tools instead of only building.

Discoverability

Problems Today

New users struggle to understand what Zapier does and where it can help them in their business.

Existing users struggle to understand what other things Zapier can do beyond their initial use case.

Enablement

Problems Today

Users who have a sense of what they want to do can't figure out how to use Zapier to setup their workflow.

Users don't understand everything Zapier can help with as they don't understand technical pieces like Paths, Webhooks, Filters...etc

Users forget how they built a Zap and feel overwhelmed trying to figure out what it does and how it works.
